Music of Carole King, Friday March 15, 2019

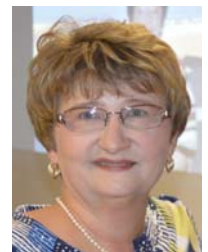
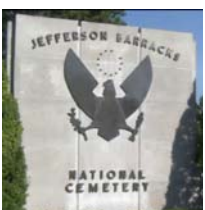
