

After breakfast, you will have a full day to explore the magnificent **Biltmore Estate** during its most lovely time of year. An included audio tour gives the feeling of being guided through Biltmore's grand rooms by their curators. On this 90-minute tour, you'll learn about the Vanderbilts, their guests, and their servants, in addition to the surrounding architecture, design, and artwork. Be inspired by the phenomenal holiday decorations that you will see in the relaxed elegance of George and Edith Vanderbilt's 250-room family home and country retreat. This 19th century French Renaissance château remains America's largest privately owned home.

Utilize The Inn's complimentary shuttle to explore other areas of the estate such as the Winery where you

can take a behind-the-scenes look at how wine is crafted. Then amble over to the tasting room where gracious wine hosts are happy to guide you through a complimentary wine tasting of robust reds, refreshing rosés, and crisp whites. You may also visit **Antler Hill Village**, which connects the Biltmore's present and past. This village provides a relaxing place for dining, shopping, historical exhibits, and new ways to experience Biltmore's hospitality.

A very special evening is in store as we partake in an enchanting **Candlelight Dinner** at the estate's **Stable Café** followed by a **Christmas Candlelight self-guided tour** of the Biltmore House.

Wednesday, November 29 (Breakfast)

After breakfast we depart for the Asheville Folk Art Center, which showcases





the finest in traditional and contemporary crafts of the Southern Appalachians. Then, we're in for a unique treat as we visit the **Grove Park Inn Resort**, which was built in 1913 with granite stones mined from Asheville's Sunset Mountain. While onsite, we'll see an amazing display of **gingerbread houses**. These intricate works of art are all entries into the annual National Gingerbread House Competition. The winning entries are flown to New York City to be featured on ABC's "Good Morning America." Gingerbread never looked so good!

Later today we arrive in Nashville, TN where we'll check into the Gaylord

**Opryland Resort** for three nights. During the holiday season the hotel, in all its magnificence, is

transformed by the sparkle and spirit of Christmas. See stunningly decorated Christmas trees throughout the resort. View a breathtaking synchronization of light, water and music with the hotel's two holiday fountain shows. Visit the **Outdoor Nativity Display** with its special lighting effects. Our next stop is the fabulous **Country Music Hall of Fame**, a \$37 million, state-of-the-art facility that spans an entire city block and features miles of memorabilia. The museum tells the story of one of America's most endearing art forms through historic video clips, recorded music and dynamic exhibits. After free time for lunch on your own in downtown Nashville, we will visit the 1853 Greek-Revival **Belle Meade Plantation**. During our **guided tour** of the mansion a century of the Plantation's rich history is told through the eyes of the Harding-Jackson family and the skilled laborers who collectively worked to make this America's premier Thoroughbred horse farm. After the tour we'll be treated to a complimentary wine tasting followed by free time to explore the historic buildings, including the massive 1800's carriage house and stable. Tonight, we will take our seats for a festive **Christmas Dinner Show** at the hotel.

### Friday, December 1 (Breakfast, Lunch)

This morning a **local guide** will take us on a passage through Nashville's rich history. We'll see the historic **Tootsie's Orchid Lounge** on **Honky Tonk Row**. During our drive along **Music Row** we'll learn about the music industry and the many stars who call Nashville home. Next, we'll step aboard the **General Jackson Showboat** for a fun afternoon. While "rollin' down the river" you'll enjoy stunning views, a delicious holiday meal with all the trimmings and lively, musical entertainment. We return to the hotel where we'll experience **ICE!**, a magical adventure taking you through two million pounds of hand-carved, interactive ice sculptures that are kept at a chilly 9°F. 
