A local step-on guide will acquaint us with the charms of New Orleans complete with a break at Café du Monde. Churches of St. Louis: October 9, 2024: Greenville-Highland-Marine Pick-ups: Cost \$ 120: Due Aug 30



Come along as we tour St Louis's majestic churches. Reminder the church list could change as there may be a funeral or another event pop up; we will substitute churches if we must. We start the day at Trinity Lutheran Church for a tour by Dennis Amman Sexton. He will show you the beautiful sanctuary, their priceless communion chalice (if available), and speak of the fascinating history of this church, which was the birthplace of today's Missouri Synod. Enjoy a Lebanese cafeteria style lunch in the Cedars Banquet Hall at St. Raymond's Maronite Catholic Church. Next we are off to Christ Church Cathedral, an inspiring space for worship, prayer, and advocacy for the neighborhood and city. The Cathedral is an example of 14th century Early English Gothic and is well known for its stained-glass windows, organ, and its reredos. The reredos were carved between 1909 and 1911 and shipped to the Cathedral in 230 cases. The reredos consist of 52 religious figures and biblical scenes in stone. The last church of the day is the stunning Cathedral Basilica. This amazing architectural structure is home to 83,00 sq feet of mosaic tiles, one of the largest collections in the world.
